Greetings!

We invite you to join us at the Deception Pass Bridge 75th Anniversary celebration, “Connecting Our Communities”. The bridge turns 75 years old this coming July 31, a Saturday. We want to commemorate this significant milestone, and to join our communities together in an old-fashioned community picnic and celebration at Deception Pass State Park.

Location

The Deception Pass Bridge connects Fidalgo and Whidbey islands as part of State Route 20. It is nine miles south of Anacortes, and nine miles north of Oak Harbor. Deception Pass State Park, the busiest state park in Washington and one of the most spectacular, is located on both sides of the bridge. The East Cranberry Lake area is one mile south of the bridge, just west of State Route 20, with parking for about 150 cars. Shuttles will be available from nearby park and rides.

Vendor and Display Guidelines

- Set-up time for vendors and displays is on Saturday from 9 to 11 a.m. All booths must be set up by 11 a.m.. Check-in will be at the Deception Pass Park Foundation booth. No early set up will be allowed.
- Vendor hours will be from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Early closing and breakdown not permissible.
- Booth space will be 10 x 10 feet. You must provide your own booths, display boards, tables, chairs, and other equipment. Since booths will be outside, a tent or cover is recommended. Be aware that the ground is grass covered and will probably not be level.
- Booths must be attended at all times. Security will not be provided.
- Each exhibitor will be responsible for conducting their own sales, if any, and collecting their own sales tax. Island County sales tax is 8.7%
- There will be no electricity available. Generators will not be allowed.
- Restrooms and running water are available nearby.
- You are responsible for keeping your area clean during and after the event, making sure all trash is removed at the end of the event. All trash must be disposed of in the dumpsters located near the parking lot, or taken away.
- All booths must be broken down by 6 p.m., July 31.
- The State of Washington, Deception Pass Park Foundation, Oak Harbor Chamber of Commerce, and sponsors/presenters will not be responsible for any damage to booths, equipment, food, injury, property damage or loss sustained as a result of participating in this event.
- We recommend for your protection that you carry insurance coverage during the event for protection against bodily injury and personal damage.
- Due to limited parking space, vendors will be required to park off site. A shuttle will be provided.

Vendor or Display Application

All vendors and display booths will reflect the theme of "Connecting our Communities". Appropriate businesses and organizations will relate to the park or local area, emphasizing natural, cultural, environmental, educational, or public service values. Sales items, if any, must enhance these core values. The Deception Pass Park Foundation has the right to accept, reject, or limit vendors, displays, or materials distributed or sold, as it deems appropriate.
