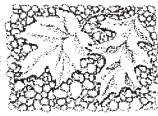


Sand Dune Discovery Trail

- a white flower
- a plant with red stems

Things that fly



- 3 different types of birds (example: seagull, eagle, & crow)
- woodpecker holes in a snag (a dead tree still standing)
what are the woodpeckers looking for? _____
- a damselfly (it looks like a dragonfly, but it's smaller & blue)

Plants and ants



- name 2 different plants found in the dunes

(hint: look on the big sign near the start of the dunes)
- lichen (don't be fooled - it's not Spanish moss)
- a conifer (look for needles and cones)
- an insect
- a tree with orange, peeling bark

- 2 types of evidence of animals
(hint: look for prints, chew marks on plants, or even poop!)
- the marsh overlook
